Guidelines & Information

In order to be considered for a banner, the nominee must meet the following requirements:

1. Lived in Wayne County at some point in their lifetime.
2. Served in one of the following branches: Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, National Guard or Navy.
3. Veteran must be honorably discharged, currently serving or died in the line of duty.
4. Photos of veteran in uniform preferred but not required. Photos should be as large as possible.

If available, please include a copy of the veteran's DD214

Banners are 24" x 48", double sided, vinyl material and include veteran's name, branch of service, era of service and photograph. Banners will be displayed on telephone poles in downtown Honesdale for a two-year period. Locations will be selected randomly. Cost per banner is \$200.

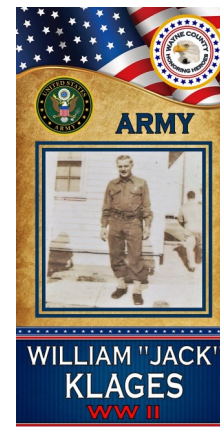
There are a limited number of locations available. Applications will be numbered in order received. Applications not processed will be put on a waiting list for when space is available.
